CHAPTER – 1
INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Read carefully before applying through e-Tendering process:

1. General

- 1.1 The e-tender is floated through the e-tendering process and only e-bids shall be accepted. Bids are invited in two bid systems, i.e. Technical Bid and Financial Bid. Firms/Companies/OEMs/Fabricators manufacturing the required Traffic equipment or their authorized dealers may only apply. Bidders shall submit sample of Traffic Barricade along with the Technical Bid.
- 1.2 Firms/Companies/OEMs/Fabricators are advised to study the document thoroughly. Submission of Technical Bids and Financial Bids shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the Technical Bid and Financial Bid document with full understanding of its implications.
- 1.3 It will be imperative on each bidder to fully acquaint himself with all the local conditions and factors, which would have any effect on the performance of the contract. No request for the change of price or time schedule of delivery of material shall be entertained, on account of any local condition or factor once the offer is accepted by the Purchaser.
- 1.4 The Standing Purchase Committee reserves the right to relax any terms & conditions in govt. interest.
- 1.5 No conditional/optional bid shall be accepted and bidders shall not be permitted to alter or modify their bids after expiry of the deadline for receipt of Bids.
- 1.6 Sample of the quoted items of the successful bidder(s) shall be retained by the department as a control sample.
- 1.7 The bidder shall be responsible to provide items at PAP, Jalandhar Cantt., Punjab.
- 1.8 All equipments must conform to the applicable rules and laws of the State Govt., Govt. of India.
- 1.9 Bidder must upload a signed copy of the tender document with seal/stamp of the firm/company.
- 1.10 Department holds the right to cancel the tender at any time due to any reason.
- 1.11 Bidder shall deposit a processing fee as mention in the portal through online mode only.

- 2.2 Bidders shall submit sample of **Traffic Barricade** along with the Technical Bid. Sample can be deposited in person by the bidding firms/companies/OEMs/Fabricators at the address mentioned below on any working day between **09:00-17:00 hrs**:

- 2.3 Sample should reach the above address on or before opening of the technical bids on the appointed date and time.
- 2.4 The Technical bids will be opened in the office of State Transport Commissioner, Punjab SCO 177-178, Sec-17-C, Chandigarh (Phone No. 0172-2771183).
- 2.5 Evaluation of samples shall be conducted post opening of the Technical Bids.
- 2.6 After evaluation of the Technical Bids, along with documents as proof submitted by the vendors, the short-listed Bidders will be intimated online regarding evaluation of the samples as per technical specifications. The decision of the committee on suitability of the offer shall be final and shall not be open for discussion.
- 2.7 Financial bids of the short-listed Bidders will be opened and bidders will be intimated online about the date and time of opening of bids.
- 2.8 Purchaser reserves the right to vary the quantity of material at the time of placement of Supply Order/Signing of Contract.
- 2.9 **Tolerance Clause**: Purchaser reserves the right & place additional orders at the same rates within 12 months of placing of purchase order.
- 2.10 The Purchaser reserves the right to accept any bid and to annul the bid process and reject all bids at any time, without assigning any reason, prior to placement of supply order/ signing of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder(s) of the grounds for the Purchaser's action.

3. Bidder Qualification:

- 3.1 **The bidder must be in business from at least past three years. In this regard, it must submit supporting documents along with technical of incorporation , Tax returns of business, balance sheets, Profit & loss accounts etc.**
- 3.2 The average annual turnover of the bidder for last 3 financial years must be at least Rs. 1 Crore. Documents regarding turnover should be certified from Chartered Accountant and should be up-loaded along with technical bid.

4. Earnest Money:-

- 4.1 Earnest Money amount shall be payable as below:-

- 4.2** Bidders shall deposit the Earnest Money **only through online mode as provided in the GePNIC portal <https://eproc.punjab.gov.in>**.
- 4.3** No interest will be payable on the Earnest Money by the Purchaser.
- 4.4** The Earnest Money may be forfeited:-
- a) If a Bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity; or
 - b) In the case of the finally selected Bidder, if the Bidder fails;
 - i. To sign the Contract in accordance Clause 1 of Chapter-2; or
 - ii. To furnish Contract Performance Security in accordance with Clause 2 of Chapter-2;or
 - iii. If at any stage any of the information/declaration is found false.
- 4.5** Earnest Money in respect of the finally selected Bidder will be discharged upon the Bidder signing the Contract, pursuant to Clause 1 of Chapter-2 and furnishing the Contract Performance Security, pursuant to Clause 2 of Chapter-2.
- 4.6** The bidder(s) must use the exemption option as provided on GePNIC portal during the online bid submission process, in case the tender is being quoted item-wise. A bidder has to pay the whole amount of EMD, as mentioned on portal, in case the exemption option is not used/applicable. In case of any clarification/difficulty during this process, the GePNIC help desk may be contacted at 0172-2970263, 2970284.

5. Period of Validity of Bids:

Bids shall remain valid for 12 (Twelve) calendar months from the date of Bid opening. A bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by the Purchaser as non-responsive.

6. Registration for GST/Taxation Department:

The bidders should have their firm/company registered with the GST (as applicable) Department and shall furnish copies of the testimonials with their Technical Bid.

7. Terms and conditions of Tendering Firms/companies:

- 7.1** Printed terms and conditions of Bidder shall not be considered as forming part of their Bids.
- 7.2** Bidder must state categorically whether or not his offer conforms to all the tender terms and conditions. If there is a variation in any of the terms and conditions, the extent of variation and the reasons thereof shall be clearly mentioned in the technical bid.
- 7.3** Bidder must state categorically whether or not his offer conforms to the requirement given in Chapter 4. Bidder must clearly specify the deviation in the bid. No alteration suggested by the vendor will be accepted.
- 7.4** Bidder must understand that the L-1 bidder have to supply the required material within the time frame mentioned in the E-Tender Document.

- 7.5 The bidder must be original manufacturer or its authorized dealer of the product. In case the bidder is authorized dealer then must submit an authorization letter along with technical bid.

8. Bid Requirements:

- 8.1 The Successful Bidder(s) shall be required to furnish Contract Performance Security of 10% of the Contract Value in the shape of Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) in the name of “Deputy Controller, (F&A) o/o State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, Chandigarh”. Performance Security (Security Deposit) has to be obtained from any successful bidder irrespective of its registration status. The FDR shall be returned by with the intend credit by the bank on it to the bidder at the end of the Guarantee or Warranty period of the respective item.
- 8.2 Bidders must submit a list of their owners, partners, etc. and a affidavit to the effect that the firm/company is neither blacklisted by any Government Department nor any criminal case is registered against the firm/company or its owner(s) or partners or director(s) anywhere in India. The firms/companies blacklisted by any Govt. Department, shall not be considered for this tender.
- 8.3 Bids submitted without depositing Tender Fee and Earnest Money will be rejected.
- 8.4 Bids will only be accepted through e-tendering process. Conditional bids, Telex/Fax bids and incomplete bids will be summarily rejected.

9. Bid Prices:

- 9.1 The Bidder shall mention the item-wise unit price including GST (as applicable) and any other incidental expenses as per the format provided in the GePNIC portal. The bidder shall be selected on the basis of total price inclusive any taxes and charges if any.
- 9.2 The Purchaser will make all payments, under this contract, in Indian rupees.
- 9.3 After opening of the price bid, no clarifications whatsoever shall be entertained by the Standing Purchase Committee.

10. Guarantee/Warranty:

- 10.1 The material to be supplied by the bidder may be got tested from any approved laboratory. If any deviation is found during the test, the entire amount of EMD will be forfeited and the firm/company may be black listed.
- 10.2 Any nominated departmental committee of the department can visit the site to inspect the material.

11. Contents of Bid:

The Bids prepared by the Bidder shall comprise of the following two components:-

- A) **Technical Bid shall be** comprising of the following and to be filled on online.

- i. Bidders Particulars.
- ii. Bid Form.
- iii. EMD to be deposited as prescribed.
- iv. Test Report, if any.
- v. Copies of GST (as applicable) Registration.
- vi. Guarantee as per tender Annexure C-3.
- vii. Certificate regarding turnover as required in Para 3.3.
- viii. Sample of the quoted items.

B) Financial Bid in accordance with the formats provided for the BoQ (Bill of Quantity).

12. Procedure for Submission of Bids:

- a. Only Bids received through e-tendering will be accepted. Same may be accessed at <https://eproc.punjab.gov.in>.
- b. Sample of quoted items may be deposited as per process mentioned at Para 2.2, 2.5 and 2.6 above.

CHAPTER - 2

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Award of Contract:

- 1.1 Prior to the expiry of the period of bid validity, the Purchaser will notify the finally selected Bidder and place the supply order within 14 days thereafter. If a need for extension of the bid validity period arises, it should be extended by mutual agreement. The notification of award/placement of supply order will constitute the formation of the Contract.
- 1.2 At the time of placement of the supply order, the finally selected Bidder shall sign the contract with the Purchaser. The finally selected Bidder shall bring along with him, the power of attorney, the contract performance security and common seal etc. for signing the contract.

2. Contract Performance Security:

- 2.1 The Contract Performance Security will be in the name of the **Deputy Controller (F&A), o/o State Transport Commissioner, Punjab.**
- 2.2 The Contract Performance Security should be valid for a period of one year from the date of placing supply order to the bidder.
- 2.3 In the event of delay in supply of material as required in the E- tender document the Bidder shall, at the request of the Purchaser, extend the validity of the Contract Performance Security so as to cover the warranty period.

3. Payment Schedule: 90% payment will be released to the bidder after delivery & Inspection of material and balance 10% payment will be released within one month after the successful completion of the supply order as per NIT Specifications.

- 3.1 No advance payment shall be made.

4. Delivery: The successful bidder shall have to supply the goods within 90 days of the issue of supply order. Delivery of goods shall be made at as mentioned above (1.7). The cost of complete delivery of goods i.e. transportation cost and transit insurance (if any) shall be born by the successful bidder. In case of delay in the supply of goods beyond 90 days, penalty @1% of the value of the contract would be imposed per month or part of month on undelivered material.

- 4.1 No recovery of penalty will be made if the delayed supplies are accepted by extending the delivery period by the Indenting Officer.
- 4.2 The Indenting Officer will allow extension on the request of the supplier by recording in writing that the exceptional circumstances were beyond the control of the supplier and there was no loss to Government.
- 4.3 On the failure of the supplier to make supply within the extended period, risk purchase at the cost of supplier will be made by the department. The difference of exceeds of cost thus incurred will be recovered from the supplier in a suitable manner, and even from his

pending bills, earnest money or security whichever is available. This procedure will be adopted after sending registered notice to the supplier to supply stores within 15 days.

5. All documents submitted by the bidders should be attested by the authorized person of the bidder.

6. Test Report and Inspection of Tests:

6.1 Inspection of the material supply: On receipt of the material, inspection will be carried out by a nominated committee of the department and only those material will be accepted, which match with the specification given in the NIT and are strictly according to the approved sample. Rejected material will have to be removed by the bidder, failing, which department shall have no responsibility for its safe keep.

6.2 The Delivery of material is not deemed to have been completed unless all the material is inspected and accepted by the Purchaser.

7. Guarantee/Warrantee:

7.1 The Supplier shall provide comprehensive Manufacture Guarantee/ Warranty for any manufacturing defect in the material as per technical specification in given Draft Notice Inviting Tender (DNIT).

7.2 If the Supplier fails to replace the defective Traffic Equipment, the Purchaser will deduct the cost from the contract performance security.

8. GST clearance Certificate should be enclosed.

9. Force Majeure: The Contractor shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is a result of an event of Force Majeure. For purposes of the clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Contractor and not involving the Contractor's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, freight embargoes etc.

10. Waiver: Failure or delay on the part of the Supplier or the Purchaser to exercise right or power hereunder shall not operate as a waiver thereof.

11. Assignability: Neither this Contract nor any rights under it may be assigned by either Party without the express prior written consent of the other Party. However, upon assignment of the assignor's interest in this Contract, the assignor shall be released and discharged from its obligations hereunder only to the extent that such obligations are assumed by the assignee.

12. Severability: If any portion of this Contract or any of the Contract Documents hereto is held to be invalid, such provision shall be considered severable, and the remainder of this Contract hereof shall not be affected.

14. Governing Law: This Contract including the Contract Documents shall be governed by and constructed in accordance with the laws of India and the Chandigarh Courts shall have jurisdiction in this regard.

15. Termination for Default:

15.1 The Purchaser may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by Thirty (30) days written notice of default sent to the Supplier and upon the Supplier's failure and neglect to propose and/or execute any corrective action to cure the default, terminate this contract in whole or in part:

- (i) If the Supplier fails to deliver the material as required in Chapter 4 within the time period(s) specified in the Contract; or
- (ii) If the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.

15.2 On termination of the Contract for default, the security deposit of the Supplier will be forfeited.

15.3 On termination of the Contract for default, action will be taken to black list the Supplier.

16. Termination for Convenience: The Purchaser shall have the right to terminate the Contract in whole or in part at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the Purchaser's convenience, the extent to which performance of work under the contract is terminated and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.

17. Resolution of Disputes: If any question, difference or objection whatsoever shall arise in any way connected with or arising out of this instrument or the meaning or operation of any part thereof or the rights, duties or liabilities of either party than save in so far as the decision of any such matter is hereinbefore provided for and has been so decided, every such matter including whether its decision has been otherwise provided for and/or whether it has finally decided accordingly of whether the contract should be terminated or has been rightly terminated in whole or part and as regards the rights and obligations of the parties as the result of such termination shall be referred for arbitration to any officer appointed by Punjab Government acting as such at the time of reference and his decision shall be final and binding and where the matter involves a claim the amount if any awarded in such arbitration shall be recoverable in respect of the matter so referred.




