**Subject: Procedure to be followed for registration of a Tractor-Trolley as a Goods Transport Vehicle and issuance of permits to it under Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for Carriage of Food Grains upto 25 km from a Purchase Centre/Mandi Yard to a delivery point.**

**Background**

1. Farmer is not required to register tractor-trolley as a goods transport vehicle to carry his agricultural produce to purchase centre or elsewhere (Notification no. S.O. 451(E) dated 19-6-1992 Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Govt. of India under sub section (4) of Section 41 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988.) However in case tractor-trolley owner intends to transport it commercially he needs to register it as a transport vehicle as explained below
2. The Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in its judgment of May 10, 1996 in the case of Dashmesh Tractor Trolley Union versus State of Punjab (1997) 116 P.L.R. 649 has held that the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 does not bar the use of tractor-trolley as a goods carriage transport vehicle. This was upheld by the Learned Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court vide judgment dated 07.01.1997 in LPA 823 of 1996 titled as State of Punjab v. Dashmesh Tractor Trolley Union, Sunam.
3. This position was reiterated by the Hon'ble High Court on April 8, 2015 in CWP 6534 of 2015 filed by the same petitioner in Dashmesh Tractor Trolley Union versus State of Punjab.
4. Procurement of food grains is an essential public function performed by the State of Punjab not only for itself but for the entire country. Tractor-trolleys which are idle after the harvest can not only augment the arrangements for transportation of large quantity of food grain purchased by state



food agencies, in a short span but also give some additional income to the farmer/owner if he opts for it.

5. In the above said background, and in the larger public interest, Government of Punjab has decided to formalise the process of registration of tractor trolleys as goods transport vehicles and issuance of permits to them for carriage of food grains, as per procedure set out hereunder.

#### Design and Certificate of Fitness:

6. Following instructions issued by the Office of the State Transport Commissioner vide office letter no. 9378-9401 dated 30.05.77, STC- G (D. Man) 21573-604 dated 12.05.97 and STC- G (D. Man) 30-45/11862-98 dated 25.03.2004 (Appendix 1) the design of the trolley to be followed in terms of Section 56 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Rule 38, 39 and 40 of the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 is as under:

5. The Government of Rajasthan also has procedure in place to register tractor trolleys as goods transport vehicles. Hence alternatively, the design approved by State of Rajasthan as per recommendations of Mechanical Wing of Jai Narayan Vyas University can also be followed (Appendix 2 and Appendix 3).

#### Board of Inspection/ Certificate of Fitness and Registration

6. Vide Notification no. 10/11/2017-TT2(PF)/1219551/1 Dated 25.4.2018 (Appendix 4) the Board for inspection for Tractor-Trolleys to be used as Transport Vehicle for carriage of Food Grains from Mandis to Godowns has been constituted as below:
  - a. Secretary, Regional Transport Authority in the Sub Division where its office is located and Sub Divisional Magistrates in rest of the Sub Divisions.
  - b. A qualified personnel serving in Govt. or recognised private Technical Institution in the Sub Division or District if not available in the Sub Division, holding at least a Diploma in Mechanical/Automobile Engineering to be nominated by Secretary, Regional Transport Authority or Sub Divisional Magistrates concerned.
7. The Maximum permissible Gross Vehicle Weight of the loaded trolley will be as per Certificate of Fitness mentioned herein-above.
8. Vide Notification no. 10/11/2017-TT2(PF)/1219502/1 Dated 25.4.2018 (Appendix 5)
  - a. Secretary, Regional Transport Authorities in the Sub Divisions where their office are located and
  - b. Sub Divisional Magistrates in rest of the Sub Divisionshave been authorised as the Licensing and Registering Authority for Tractor-Trolleys to be used as Transport Vehicle for carriage of Food Grains from Mandis to delivery points.
9. Fee to be levied for getting certificate of fitness and registration will be as is notified under Rule 81 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rule 1989. Similarly, the rates of the Motor Vehicle Tax to be paid under the Punjab Motor Vehicles Taxation Act 1924 is as per Department of Transport (Transport-II Branch) Notification dated 22.11.2007 (Appendix 6&7).
10. Third-party risk insurance taking the tractor-trolley as a transport vehicle is required under Section 146 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and rules framed thereunder.
11. The purchase invoice of the trolley should be attached with the application for registration. In case the tractor-trolley owner is unable to produce the invoice, having lost it or otherwise, he should give an undertaking that he owns the trolley in question. It should be verified by two prominent persons of the village.



12. The trolley to be registered should be linked to the registration record of a particular tractor which must be owned by the person who applies for registration of the trolley to be coupled to it.
13. As the chassis number is required for registration of a vehicle, the registering authority shall take the registration number of the tractor suffixed by 'TT' as chassis number of the trolley to be attached to it. For example if the tractor bears a registration number PB 01 AA 5355, the chassis number PB01AA5355TT will be assigned to its trolley. This should be painted prominently in the same manner as a registration number, behind the trolley in its middle.

**Issuance of Permit for carriage of food grains upto 25 km from a Mandi Yard**

14. Vide Notification no. 10/11/2017-TT2(PF)/1219535/1 Dated 25.4.2018 (Appendix 8) Secretary, Regional Transport Authorities in the Sub Divisions where their office are located and Sub-Divisional Magistrates in rest of the Sub Divisions have been authorised to grant permit to Tractor-Trolley for the limited purpose of carriage of food grains, from any Mandi Yard/ Purchase Centre to a delivery point not farther than 25km from it, of which a maximum of 12 km can be on a state highway/national highway, which shall be mentioned on the permit. A delivery point can be a godown, a plinth, a warehouse, a railway siding etc.
15. Application fee for grant of permit under Rule 67 and Permit fee under Rule 68 of the Punjab Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 will be as notified therein (Appendix 9).
16. The trolleys may not be called to office for the registration and the registration certificates and permits may be issued on the spot in a camp mode.
17. Wherever not specifically stated the procedure and requirements as regards goods carriage/transport vehicles under the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 shall apply, as the case may be, and as may be applicable, from time to time.
18. LMV, (Transport) license vehicle will be required to drive the tractor trolleys as a Goods Transport Vehicle.

The overall width of Tractor Trolley shall not exceed 2.0 metres (7'2") including hooks on both the sides.

2. Overall Length

The overall length shall not exceed:-

- (a) In the case of two wheeled Trolleys for tractors up to 20 H.P. including hitching beam and hook.
- (b) In the case of ~~four~~ <sup>two</sup> wheeled trolleys for tractors from 21 H.P. to 50 H.P. 16' including hitching beam and hook.
- (c) In the case of four wheeled trolleys 20' including hitching beam and hook.

3. Overall Height

of Trolleys

The overall height shall not exceed:-

- (a) In the case of two wheeled tractor trolleys for tractors up to 20 H.P. 10' from the ground when loaded.
- (b) In the case of two wheeled tractor trolleys for tractor 21 H.P. to 50 H.P. and for four wheeled trolleys 11'.

4. Six yellow coloured self glowing glasses must be provided on front side of the trolleys in the form of two inverted triangles (one on either side).

5. Six red coloured glowing glasses (2" dia maximum) must be provided on the back side of the trolleys in the form of two inverted triangles (one on either side).

6. There must be number plate on the back side of the trolley.

7. There must be a rear lamp showing red light displayed according to rule 5.2(1) of Motor Vehicles Rules, 1947.





RULES

1. These rules may be called the Punjab Motor Vehicles (First Amendment) Rules, 2008.

2. In the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 2, after clause (d), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(dd) “Document Verification Certificate” means a certificate issued by an officer, authorized by the State Government, in such form, as may be specified by the State Government, after checking the correctness and validity of documents and payment of tax of a vehicle;”

3. In the said rules, in rule 67, in sub-rule (1), in the table, in item (A), against sub-item (a), under heading captioned as “Rate of Fee”, for the letter and figures “Rs. 2,000”, the letter and figures “Rs. 10 000” shall be substituted.

4. In the said rules, in rule 68,—

(i) in sub-rule (1), in the table, items (a), (c) and (d) and the entries relating thereto, shall be omitted : and

(ii) after sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(1-A) The following fees shall be payable for the issue and renewal of permits under the Act, namely:—

5. In the said rules, after rule 68-A, the following rules shall be inserted, namely:—

“68-B. Issue of Document Verification Certificate :—(1) If an owner of a transport vehicles (Goods) registered in the State of Punjab, desires to obtain a Document Verification Certificate in respect of such vehicle, he may make an application to an officer, authorized by the State Government, at the time of grant or renewal of Annual Fitness Certificate of such vehicle alongwith a fee of Rs. 550.00 per ton on the gross weight of such vehicle.

(2) In respect of a transport vehicle (Goods) registered in the States, other than the State of Punjab, the Document Verification Certificate may be issued on demand while entering such vehicles in the State of Punjab, after checking the correctness and validity of documents and the payment of tax. The fee rate for documents Verification Certificate per trip for such vehicle, shall be as under :—

- (a) Light Motor Vehicle ; Rs. 400.00
- (b) Medium Goods Vehicles ; Rs. 600.00
- (c) Heavy Goods Vehicles ; Rs. 800.00
- not exceeding 9 tonnes ;

(3) The owner of the motor car having seating capacity up to nine seats, may also obtain Document Verification Certificate on payment of fee of Rs. 1,000 per seat per annum.

(4) The Document Verification Certificate is to be displaced on the front of windscreen of the vehicle in respect of which, it has been issued. The display of this certificate will indicate that all documents of the vehicle have been checked up and are found to be correct and such vehicle shall not be checked up again for those documents by the transport authority, police or any other authority.

**68-C Period for operation of transport vehicles.**—The period for operation of transport vehicles shall be as under :—

Serial No.	Type of Vehicles	Maximum period of operation
(a)	Motor Cabs (taxis) ;	Fifteen years.
(b)	Maxi Cabs ; and	Fifteen years.
(c)	Three wheeler-auto-rickshaws	Fifteen years."

6. In the said rules, in rule 77, after sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule shall be added, namely :—

"(5) An holder of a permit of stage carriage (i.e. big bus), can replace such stage carriage bus into a new Heat Ventilation and Air Condition/Integral Coach with the approval of the Regional Transport Authority as per the specifications, approval by the State Government."

7. In the said rules, after rule 80, the following rule shall be inserted namely :—

“80-A. Clubbing of permits.—(1) If the holder of a permit have spare different permits on the same route, he may apply to the Regional Transport Authority for clubbing those permits into one composite permit with the same number of return trips.

(2) If there is any return trip, which exceeds the clubbing return trips, referred to in sub-rule (1), the same shall be surrendered by the holder of the permit.”.
