- 2. The non operational status of the VLT device shall be determined based on the data/feed not received in real time on State/NIC backend /common layer application /Command Control Centre.
- 3. In case the VLTD fails to send required data to the monitoring centre due to technical failure/fault/ physical damage etc. The Public service vehicle owner shall deposit the dysfunctional VLT device to its manufacturer or authorized dealer within 3 days and shall submit the receipt obtained from service centre to the concerned Secretary, Regional Transport Authority. It will be the responsibility of the concerned VLTD manufacturer/ authorized dealer to immediately re-fix the device on the ve hicle after service.

4. The notification will be effective from 1st August, 2022.
