No.10/51/2011-172/1350 In pursuance of the provisions of Rule 3 of the Punjab Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint Registrar of Punjabi University, Patiala, Registrar of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Registrar of Baba Farid Medical University, Faridkot, Registrar of Punjab Agriculture University, Ludhiana, Registrar of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Science University, Ludhiana and Registrar or Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar as Licensing Authorities of their respective University for issuing learners licence to their students only subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 7,8 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988 and Rule 4,10 and 11 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

To authorize the Registrar of Punjabi University, Patiala, Registrar of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Registrar, Baba Farid University Faridkot, Registrar, Punjab Agriculture University, Registrar, Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Science University and Registrar Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar for issuing of learners lincense to their students to drive the vehicles guidelines thereof.

The state Govl. has authorised Registrar of Punjabi University, Patiala, Registrar of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, Registrar Baba Farid Medical University Faridkol, , Registrar of Punjab Agriculture University Ludhiana, Registgrar of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Science University, Ludhiana and Registar Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar for issuing learners license to the students of their Universities only to drive the vehicles, under the provisions of Motor Vehicles, Act 1988, Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and Punjab Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989. With a view to follow the procedure for the purpose, the following guidelines are to be adhered to:-

- The provisions of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, Rule 4, 5,6, 7,10,11,12 and 13 of the Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989, the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and instructions issued under the MV Act/Rules are to be followed meticulously.
- The prescribed fee under Rule 32 of Central Motor Vehicles, Rules, 1989 is to be charged by issuing receipts so obtained from the office of the Distirct Transport Officers/Sub Divisional Magistrates except Distl. H.Q. and deposited into the Govt. treasury under the prescribed Head of Motor Vehicles Department.
- The receipt books for collection of fee in respect of issue of learners lincense and registers to maintain the record shall be obtained from the concerned District Transport Officer/ Sub Divisional Magistrate (except Distt. H.Q). The record shall be

maintained in these registers properly and shall be produced for inspection/audit before the competent authority

The application for learners license shall be received in form 2 prescribed in the Central Motor Vehicles, Rules 1989 alongwith the following documents:-

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- i) Save as otherwise provided in Rule 6, a medical certificate in form I-A
- ii) Three copies of the applicants recent passport size photographs
- iii) Appropriate fee as prescribed under Rule 32 of CMV Rules
- iv) Proof of residence as specified under Rule 4 of CMV Rules, 1989.
- v) Proof of age as specified under Rule 4 of CMV Rules, 1989 vi) Proof of citizenship
- While submitting application for issuing learners license, every applicant shall present himself before the the Registrars, as the case may be for a preliminary test and satisfy them regarding adequate knowledge and understanding of the traffic sign, traffic signal and Rules of the road Regulations as specified under Rule 11 of the CMV Rules, 1989, on such date place and time as may be appointed for the purpose.
- On having been passed the preliminary test by the applicant, learners license shall be issued in form 3 as specified in CMV Rules 1989 subject to the provision of Section 4, 7 and 8 of the Motor Vehicles, Act, 1988.
- Periodical statements shall be submitted to office of the Distirct
  Transport Officers/Sub Divisional Magistrates (except Distt. 14.Q.)
  under intimation to the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab.
- Any information sought by the Transport Department shall be supplied within the prescribed period.

In case of any irregularity and violation of the provise is of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, The Central Motor Vehicles, rules, 1989 and the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and Instructions issued under the Act/Rules, action under the law is liable to be taken.
