The 21st October, 1997

No. S. O. 112/C. A. 59/88/S. 102/97.—Whereas a Scheme under the provisions of section 99 read with section 100 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988) was published,—*vide* Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S. O. 41/C. A. 59/88/100/90, dated the 9th August, 1990 ;

AND WHEREAS in exercise of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), the modifications to the above said Scheme were published as required by sub-section (2) of the said section for inviting objections and suggestions thereon,—*vide* Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S.O. 3/C. A. 59/88/S. 102/95, dated the 1st February, 1995 ;

AND WHEREAS the objections received in response to the proposal have been considered by the Government of Punjab ;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Punjab is of the opinion that it is necessary in public interest to do so ;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 102 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to publish the following modifications in the aforesaid Scheme dated the 9th August, 1990, namely :—

MODIFICATIONS

In the said Scheme,—

1. In clause (1), after sub-clause (c), the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely :—

"(cc) "Mini Bus" means a stage carriage the body of which shall be fabricated on a Chassis, the wheelbase of which does not exceed 137 inches and which does not carry more than thirty passengers besides the driver and the conductor, or as may be specified by the State Transport Authority, from time to time." ;

2. for clause (2), the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

"(2) All Inter-State routes shall be operated by the State Transport Undertakings and operations of private operators whose permits were valid for a period of three years from the date of the publication of the Scheme, shall remain unaffected ;

Provided that the route operated by a private Operator, which became Inter-State route as a result of reorganisation of the State of Punjab in the year 1966, shall not be affected by the Scheme :

Provided further that the operations of any State, other than the State of Punjab or any Union Territory including their Private Operators, operating on any route by virtue of the reciprocal agreement or permits granted by such other States and countersigned by the State Transport Authority or by the Regional Transport Authority concerned, as the case may be, shall remain unaffected :

Provided further that a permit may be granted to a Private Operator for operations of Air-Conditioned Buses from the District Headquarter and important towns in the State of Punjab to the Union Territory, Chandigarh." ;

3. for clause (4), the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

"(4) [All future operations on monopoly routes shall be operated by the State Transport Undertakings ;

Provided that a Private Operator may be allowed to operate on a portion of twenty per cent of the monopoly route or upto the distance of fifteen kilometres of the said route whichever is less, where it is necessary or is in public interest to do so :

Provided further that the permits granted by the Regional Transport Authority before coming into force of the Scheme to the private operators for operating on monopoly routes, wholly or on portion thereof or on the routes in which the monopoly routes fall, shall remain unaffected." ;

4. in clause (5), for the figures and sign "70:30", the figures and sign "75:25" shall be substituted, :

5. in clauses (6) and (7).—

(i) the words "other than the routes specified in clauses (2), (3) and (4)" shall be omitted ; and

(ii) for the figures and sign "50:50", the figures, sign and words "40:60" including the operations of Mini Buses and Inter-State operations" shall be substituted ;

6. after clause (7), the following clauses shall be inserted, namely :—

"(7-A) While granting permits for operation on routes, linking one village with another village without any city or a town or municipality, in between the aforesaid two villages, or a route linking a village with the block Headquarter or a municipality or town or mandi or city, or for service within a town, municipality or city, the use of Mini Buses may be allowed on the basis of passenger road transport needs as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab from time to time :

Provided that—

- (a) the total length of each such route does not exceed 25 kilometres and the total operation per bus, does not exceed 250 kilometres per day ;
 - (b) not more than half of the total routes length runs across a National Highways or State Highways ;
 - (c) at least one of the terminal of the route shall be a village and shall not include more than one municipality except on a local route falling within the municipal limits of a town, municipality or city wherein both the starting and the terminating points may be the same or may fall within the same town, municipality or city, as the case may be ; and
 - (d) it shall be ensured that the interest of the State Transport Undertakings are not affected adversely on such routes ;
- (7-B) State Carriage permits may be granted for operating maxi cabs within the municipal limits of a town, municipality or city, as the case may be" ; and

(7) clause (8) shall be omitted".

No. S.O. 102/C.A. 59/1988/Ss. 99 and 100/2011.—Whereas an approved scheme under the provisions of section 99 read with Section 100 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988) was framed and published,—*vide* Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S.O. 41/C.A.59/88/100/90, dated the 9th August, 1990 ;

And Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 102 of the aforesaid Act, the modifications in the above said Scheme were published as required by sub-section (2) of the said section 102 for inviting objections and suggestions thereon,—*vide* Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S.O. 39/C.A.59/1988/Ss. 99 and 100/2011, dated the 2nd May, 2011 ;

And whereas the objections or suggestions received in response to the proposed modification have been considered by the Government of Punjab ;

And whereas, the Governor of Punjab is of the opinion that it is necessary in public interest to do so :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 102 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following modifications in the aforesaid Scheme dated 9th August, 1990, namely :—

MODIFICATIONS

In the said scheme,—

1. In clause I,—

- (a) Sub-clause (cc) shall be omitted ;
- (b) for sub-clause (d), the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely :—
“(d) “National Highways” means the National Highways as notified by the Central Government from time to time ;”
- (c) for sub-clause (f), the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely :—
“(f) “State Highways” means the State Highways as notified

by the State Government from time to time ;"

2. For clauses (2), (3), (4), (5), (6) and (7), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely :—

"(2) All stage carriage permits, which were granted in favour of the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators, on the inter-State routes, shall remain un-affected till the date of their expiry :

Provided that the routes operated by the private operators, which became inter-State routes as a result of re-organization of the State of Punjab in the year 1966, shall remain un-affected :

Provided further that operation of any State Transport Undertaking, other than that of the State of Punjab or any Union Territory, as the case may be, including the private operators of such other State or Union Territory, as the case may be, operating on any route by virtue of the reciprocal agreement or permits granted by such other State or Union Territory, and are countersigned by the State Transport Authority or Regional Transport Authority concerned, shall also remain un-affected.

(3) All future stage carriage permits for operation on inter-State routes as per the reciprocal agreements or mutual understanding between the State and Union Territory concerned, as the case may be, shall exclusively be granted in favour of the State Transport Undertaking :

Provided that a permit, may be granted to a private operator for operation of an Air-conditioned Integral Coach or a Super Integral Coach, as the case may be, from a district head quarter or any important town and the Union Territory, and on the basis of the need so assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, from time to time :

Provided further that the private operators of the Heat Ventilation and Air Conditioned Buses (HVAC) and Air-conditioned Integral Coaches or Super Integral Coaches, as the case may be, may also be allowed to operate on the neighboring inter-State routes (maximum up to a distance of fifteen kilometers) falling in any other State if the terminal falls within that limit, subject to the

conditions agreed to in the reciprocal agreement with the State concerned :

Provided that the private operators may be allowed to operate only up to fifteen kilometers or twenty percent of the total length of the monopoly route, whichever is less :

Provided further that the operation of the Air-conditioned Integral Coaches or Super Integral Coaches, as the case may be, which are not more than eight years old, shall be allowed keeping in view the need so assessed by the State Transport Commissioner from time to time, only on the overlapping portion of such monopoly route or a part thereof :

Provided further that the permits granted by the Regional Transport Authority to the private operators before the coming into force of this amendment, shall remain unaffected.

- (5) All stage carriage permits for operation of the routes on the National Highway falling within the State other than the routes specified in clauses (2), (3) and (4), shall be granted to the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators in the ratio of 75:25, which shall be determined on the basis of the passenger and road transport need as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner from time to time.
- (6) All future stage carriage permits on the State Highways falling within the State other than the routes specified in clauses (2), (3) and (4), shall be granted to the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators in the ratio of 40:60, which shall be determined on the basis of the passenger and road transport need as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner from time to time.
- (7) All future stage carriage permits on the district and other roads falling within the State other than the routes specified in clauses (2), (3) and (4), shall be granted to the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators in the ratio of 40:60, which shall be determined on the basis of the passenger and road transport need as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner from time to time.";

3. Clause 7-A shall be omitted :

4. After clause 7-B, the following clauses shall be added,
namely :—

- "(8) The existing operations of the stage carriage permits of the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators of the State of Punjab, shall remain unaffected.
- (9) All existing permits may be renewed after their expiry in accordance with the provisions of section 81 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (10) Any route of a State Transport Undertaking or a private operator, may be curtailed or extended or their number of trips may be increased or decreased, as the case may be, on the basis of the passenger and road transport need as assessed by the State Transport Commission from time to time :

Provided that the operation of an existing permit on a route may be extended up to 24 kilometers at a time from the termini which may further be extended up to another 24 kilometers from the next termini of the route and so on, on the basis of the passenger and road transport need as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner from time to time."

In the Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S.O.102/C.A.59/1988/Ss. 99 and 100/2011, dated the 20th December, 2011, published in the Legislative Supplement of the *Punjab Government Gazette (Extraordinary)*, dated the 20th December, 2011, in the heading 'MODIFICATIONS', in serial No. 2, in clause (3), after first proviso,—

For "Provided further that the private operators of the Heat Ventilation and Air Conditioned Buses (HVAC) and Air-conditioned Integral Coaches or Super Integral Coaches, as the case may be, may also be allowed to operate on the neighboring inter-State routes (maximum upto a distance of fifteen kilometers) falling in any other State if the terminal falls within that limit, subject to the conditions agreed to in the reciprocal agreement with the State concerned :"

Read "Provided further that the private operators of the Heat Ventilation and Air Conditioned Buses (HVAC) and Air Conditioned Integral Coaches or Super Integral Coaches, as the case may be, may also be allowed to operate on the neighboring inter-State routes (maximum upto a distance of fifteen kilometers) falling in any other State if the terminal falls within that limit, subject to the conditions agreed to in the reciprocal agreement with the State concerned.

- (4) All future Stage carriage permits on monopoly routes, shall exclusively be granted in favour of State Transport Undertakings :".

No. S.O.239/C.A.59/1988/S.99/2010.—Whereas, the Governor of Punjab is of the opinion that for the purpose of providing an efficient, adequate, economical and properly co-ordinated road transport service, it is necessary in the public interest that road transport service in relation to whole areas of the State of Punjab, should be run and operated by the State Transport Undertakings to the complete or partial exclusion of other persons by providing mini bus service, linking villages with the Block headquarters or municipality or town or city;

And whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by section 99 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, (Central Act No. 59 of 1988), the proposal regarding a scheme for the aforesaid purpose was formulated and objections thereto were invited under sub-section (1) of section 100 of the aforesaid Act by the Government of Punjab, Department of Transport, Notification No. S.O. 35/C.A.59/1988/S.99/2009, dated the 19th August, 2009;

And whereas, the objections received in response to the proposal have been considered by the Government of Punjab as required under sub-section (2) of section 100 of the said Act;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 100 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following Scheme, namely :—

SCHEME

1. (1) This scheme may be called the Punjab Mini Bus Service Scheme, 2010.
2. It shall come into force on and with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Scheme, unless the context otherwise requires,—
 - (a) "Indicative Routes" means the routes, specified in Schedule 'D' ;
 - (b) "Mini Bus" means a stage carriage, the body of which shall be fabricated on a chassis, the wheelbase of which does not exceed 154 inches and which does not carry more than thirty passengers besides the driver and the conductor, or as may be specified by the State Transport Authority from time to time ;
 - (c) "Monopoly Routes" means the routes, specified in Schedule 'A' ;

- (d) "National Highways" means the National Highways, specified in Schedule 'B' ;
- (e) "Private Operator" means a person, who holds a permit, granted to him by the competent Authority ;
- (f) "State Highways" means the Highways, specified in Schedule 'C' ; and
- (g) "Schedule" means a Schedule appended to this scheme.
3. The following shall be the State Transport Undertakings, namely :—
- The Punjab Roadways ; and
 - The Papsu Road Transport Corporation.
4. All future operations on monopoly routes shall, exclusively, be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings.
5. All future operations on the indicative routes, shall be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings and private operators in the ratio of 20.80, respectively, which shall be determined on the basis of passengers road transport needs, as assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, from time to time, subject of the conditions that,—
- the total length of each such route does not exceed 25 kilometers and total mileage shall not exceed 250 Kms ;
 - not more than 1/4th of the route length runs across a National Highway ;
 - not more than half of the route runs across a State Highway ;
 - one of the terminus of the route shall be a village ;
 - no municipality or town or city should fall in the route ; and
 - the second terminus may be a municipality or town or city : Provided that the existing mini bus permit holders shall be allowed to continue to operate their buses on the same terms and conditions on which they were operating prior to the publication of this scheme : Provided further that the State Transport Commissioner may formulate any new route, if required to do so in public need, subject to the above conditions.
6. The route permit shall be allotted as per the procedure laid down under rule 128 of the Punjab Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.
7. The Punjab Mini Bus Scheme, 2007, published in the Punjab Government Gazette on the 14th November, 2008, is hereby repealed.

No. S.O. 41/C.A. 59/88/S. 100/90.—Whereas the President of India is of opinion that for the purpose of providing an efficient, adequate, economical and properly coordinated road transport service, it is necessary in the public interest that road transport services in relation to certain areas and routes should be run and operated by the State Transport Undertakings to the complete or partial exclusion of other persons;

And whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by section 99 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988), the proposals regarding a Scheme for the aforesaid purpose were formulated and objections thereto were invited as required under section 10 of the aforesaid Act,—*vide* Government of Punjab, Department of Transport Notification No. S.O. 73/CA. 59/88/S. 99/89, dated the 11th August, 1989;

And whereas the objections received in response to the proposals have been considered by the Government of Punjab;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 100 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988), the President of India is pleased to notify the following Scheme, namely:—

SCHEME

- (1) In the Scheme, unless the context otherwise requires,—
 - (a) 'Annexure' means an Annexure annexed to this Notification;
 - (b) 'appointed day' means the 9th day of August, 1990;
 - (c) 'monopoly routes' means the routes specified in Annexure 'A';
 - (d) 'National Highways' means the National Highways specified in Annexure 'B';
 - (e) 'Private Operator' means any permit holder existing or those who may be granted permits in future but other than the State Transport Undertakings; and
 - (f) 'State Highways' means the State Highways specified in Annexure 'C'.

(2) All inter-State routes shall be operated by the State Transport Undertaking as hitherto-fore and present operation of private operators shall remain unaffected till the validity of their route permits or for three years from the date of final publication of the scheme, whichever later. This may be reviewed after three years by the State Government:

Provided that the routes operated by the private operators which become inter-State routes as a result of re-organisation of the State of Punjab in the year 1966, shall not be affected by this Scheme.

(3) All future operations on inter-State routes in accordance with the reciprocal agreements or understanding between the concerned States and the Union Territories shall exclusively be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings.

(4) All operations existing or future on monopoly routes shall exclusively be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings.

(5) All future operations of routes on the National Highways falling within the State shall be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings and the private operators in the ratio of 70:30 which shall be determined on the basis of the passenger road transport needs, as so assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, from time to time. The existing operations of the State Transport Undertakings on the National Highways falling within the State are given in Annexures 'D' and 'D-I'.

(6) All future operations of routes on the State Highways other than the routes specified in clauses 2, 3 and 4 shall be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings and private operators in the ratio of 50:50 which shall be determined on the basis of the passenger road transport needs, as so assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, from time to time. The existing operation of routes of the State Transport Undertakings on the State Highways are given in Annexures 'E' and 'E-I'.

(7) All future operations of routes other than the routes specified in clauses 2, 3 and 4 on District and other roads shall be undertaken by the State Transport Undertakings and private operators in the ratio of 50:50 on the basis of i.e. passenger road transport needs, as so assessed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab, from time to time.

(8) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Scheme,—

(i) the services of persons of any State other than the State of Punjab or any Union Territory, operating on any route, by virtue of any reciprocal agreement or understanding shall not be affected; and

(ii) the operation of mini bus services, shall be undertaken in accordance with the Scheme notified, — vide Government of Punjab, Department of Transport Notification No. S.O. 37/C.A. 4/39/S. 43-A/80, dated the 18th June, 1980.
